Welcome to your Country Club on Lake Murray! Please take time to read through the guidelines which are enforced at Spinner's Resort. The guidelines are designed to make everyone's experience enjoyable. We expect all members will follow them. Members are responsible for making sure that their guests are aware of the guidelines and adhere to them as well. Failure to do so will result in membership cancellation.

Boat Parking: If you are a member, you may park in any boat slip at either dock marked "Members Only". Do not park in slips marked "Reserved" or in roped-off slips as these are for cottage guests. Please arrive with your guests on your boat, we do not have enough slips to accommodate guest boat parking; especially on the weekends.
Please DO NOT beach your boat or jet ski on the Sand Bar beach area.

Membership: Be prepared to show the dock hand assisting you and the hostess your membership card upon arrival. If you do not have your card, we can look you up on our system with a valid ID. We will not admit anyone without ID. When your membership expires, you will be required to renew before you can come onto the property. You can check the status of your membership on line at www.spinnersresort.com Annual billing occurs each January. Your first year will be pro-rated at that time.

Guest Policy: We hope you will encourage others to experience Spinner's Resort, but, PLEASE do not abuse the guest privilege Your membership entitles you to bring any number of guests as often as you like, up to three (3) times per guest. After a third visit, the guest must join. Guests can come with you, OR if you are not present, you must call them in ahead of time. All guests will be required to present a valid ID and sign a guest list. We will not admit anyone without a valid ID. Please advise your guests that they CAN NOT use your name to gain admittance if they are not on our guest list, they will be turned away.. Take advantage of GUESTS PASSES which you can freely distribute, guests with a pass can come anytime they choose. HOWEVER, dues are vital to the success and operations of the facility. Please encourage your friends and family to join Spinner's Resort! We prefer to accept new members from members, which is why we do not advertise.

Reservations: Effective April 1st 2010 – Spinner's Resort summer reservation procedure will change to the following:

- Reservations for regular summer dining will no longer be accepted, EXCEPT for Prime Time Nights, holidays or special events; which will be noted in emails.

- All dining in the Main Restaurant & Sand Bar will be first come first serve and handled by our host staff
- A wait list will be available for tables with a call ahead wait list service available
- Our call ahead wait list works as following:
 - Call Spinner's Resort when you are 15 – 20 minutes away.
 - We will add you to our current wait list.
 - Your name then will be treated as any other guests on the wait list
 - Once your name comes to turn your party will be sat
 - You must be present to honor your call ahead wait list request; if you are not present, you will be re added to the wait list for normal wait once you arrive
 - This service does NOT guarantee you a table upon your arrival; it simply speeds up your waiting process
 - The host will give you an estimate wait time over the phone; this is not set in stone, but is an estimate.
 - We do not recommend you call any further in advance than 15 minutes
- Reservations will be made for Group events and large parties and should be booked in advance with Brandon Hamm.

Dress Code: The dress code for the restaurant and the restaurant deck is dressy/casual. Men, please no tank tops. We offer fine dining so, when you are on the restaurant deck, or passing through, please wear cover-ups, shirts and shoes.

Sand Bar: While at the Sand Bar, members are welcome to sun bathe. Shirts and shoes are not required; however, when crossing through the restaurant dining areas, we ask that you cover up!

MISC. Spinner's Resort is first and foremost a family place. Because Spinner's Resort is designed for all ages; we expect all members and guests to refrain from any behavior or language that is inappropriate or questionable.

Special Events and private parties are permitted at Spinner's Resort, please observe all courtesies should you arrive during a wedding or other special occasion.

Glass is not permitted in the Sand Bar area. Your waitress or hostess can provide a plastic cup if you are going to the Sand Bar. Please ask for plastic to avoid any broken glass in the sand!

Smoking is not allowed inside the main restaurant. Please, please use the ashtrays when outside, cigarette ashes and butts are not easy to clean out of the parking lot and Sand Bar! Let's keep the sand clean!

If you are not dining in Spinner's main restaurant, please use the Beach House restrooms located in the Sand Bar, you may also use the Ship's Store restrooms.

Only the Sand Bar menu is available in the Sand Bar Restaurant. Coolers are not permitted in the Sand Bar; leaving and returning with personal drinks is not permitted. Please support your club!

Pets are not permitted on Spinner's Resort property

Swim at your own risk. Watch your children at all times. Life guards are not present. Please do not visit the property during hours which we are not open.
